Beverly Anne Wedeking passed away Thursday, November 29th, surrounded by family, at North Iowa Hospice after a hard fought battle with cancer for 20 years.

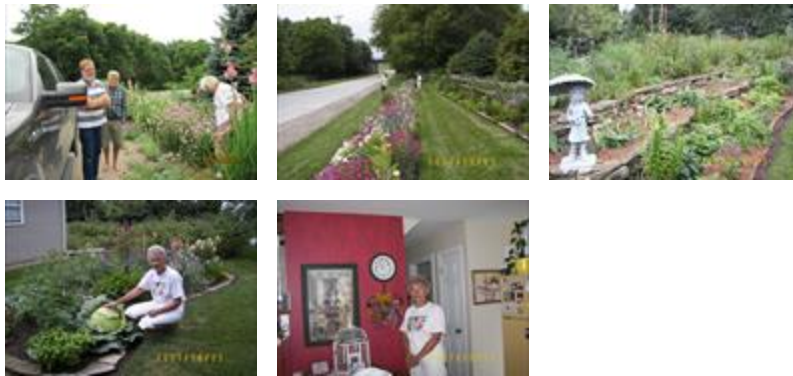
