Clinton "Clint" Harold Beggs, 74, of Mason City, IA died Saturday, February 6, 2016 at his home.

Visitation will be 5-7 pm on Thursday, February 11, 2016 at Fullerton Funeral Home. Funeral services will be at 10:30 am with a one hour prior visitation on Friday, February 12, 2016 at Fullerton Funeral Home. Reverend Roger Henry will be officiating. 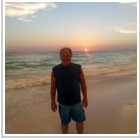
