Elizabeth "Betty" Kellogg, 94, of Charles City, IA died on Wednesday, September 29, 2020 at 11th Street Chautauqua Nursing Home in Charles City.

She was very active in the community and volunteered at the Floyd County

Hospital as an escort from admissions and also in the gift shop. Betty belonged to Citizens Bank Heritage Club, Senior Citizens 60+ Club in Floyd and Charles City Women's club. Betty played "500" in the hospice marathon and also enjoyed playing bingo.
