Francis "Frank" Patrick Boyle, 51, of Mason City, died Tuesday, August 22, 2017, at Good Shepherd Health Center, Mason City.

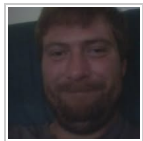

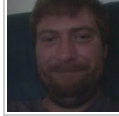

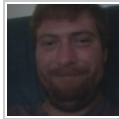
