Hazel L. Arndt, 92, of Mason City, died Saturday, June 20, 2015 at Muse Norris Hospice Inpatient Unit.

She has been a lifelong resident of Mason City. She was employed in housekeeping with Mercy Hospital and later the Odd Fellows home. She was an excellent seamstress and made quilts, dolls, wedding and bridesmaid dresses for relatives and friends including her granddaughter. She tended her

flower and vegetable gardens canning many of the fruits of her labors. In the summers the family would go to St. Germain and Rhinelander, Wisconsin and Decorah to camp and fish. Hazel was a very good fisherwoman and enjoyed going for the Walleye. Just to sit early in the morning and drink her coffee on the dock was a pure pleasure for her. Her favorite sports teams included the Minnesota Twins. For three years she stayed at Homestead assisted living and rarely missed the Friday lunches with 5 to 15 of her family members attending. In March of this year she moved to the Rockwell Care Center for better care of her health. She will be well remembered for her strong and feisty personality and had her funny times with other people. Hazel loved to go to Grandmothers club, card clubs, the VFW ladies auxiliary and the ladies of the Moose as a life time member.
