Josephine "Josie" R. Gasca 82, of Mason City, died Friday, September 9, 2016 at the IOOF home in Mason City.

To this union was born three daughters. Josie was faithful to her church for many years until her health declined but retained her faith until the end. Raising her girls she developed a strong sense of family, and was non-judgmental in her caring of the family. She always enjoyed the annual band festival, as well as going to

the community kitchen and sitting outside her home so she could visit with everyone. She loved cooking and would often start at 2:00 am to make tortillas for many people, she also loved doing laundry and working on word search puzzles.
