Kenneth “Kenny” E. Meacham, 82, of Mason City, IA died at home on Thursday, June 19, 2014. Online condolences may be left at www.fullertonfh.com.

Kenny was born on March 19, 1932 in Mason City to Abraham and Florence (Roethler) Meacham. He grew up in Mason City and graduated Mason City High School in 1950. Kenny was a two time State Champion and three time State Qualifier Wrestler. He was a West Coast National Champion. In 2011, Kenny was inducted into the Wrestling Hall of Fame. After graduation Kenny enlisted in the Marines. He wrestled while in the Marine Corp. Kenny served in the Korean Conflict until becoming injured and honorably medically discharged. He was honored for his service with a Purple Heart. Kenny later received a Silver Star. After returning to the United States, Kenny was united

in marriage on August 1, 1953 to the love of his life, Rosemarie Freeseaman. To this union four children were born. As a family they resided on a farm outside of Plymouth in 1962. Before becoming a farmer Kenneth worked for Farmers Elevator in Mason City. He later began farming full time. Farming was what he knew how to do since the young age of 15, when he started working on his grandfather's farm. He loved farming; it was his whole life.
