Larry L. Hall, 78 of Rockford, died Friday, March 10, 2017 at his home in Rockford.

They enjoyed riding their bicycles around town and going to Oregon in the summer to visit with Maxine's family. After Maxine's passing, Larry began driving truck for Ruan as a way of keeping busy.

He spent his childhood fishing Rockford's area rivers and lakes. Larry was a

hard worker, always helping neighbors with projects doing odds and ends. He enjoyed being back on a farm, helping Kevin Smith and others with whatever they needed to have done. Larry was an avid fan of his grandchildren's sports and school activities. In his later years he spent time watching old western movies, having coffee with his friends, doing puzzles and bird watching.

He is survived by his only child Cheryl and her husband Monte Cochran of Urbandale, IA; four grandchildren Katie Lindgren of Des Moines, Kristen Lindgren of West Des Moines, Jake Cochran and Michael Cochran of Urbandale; three sisters Mariel (Ken) Kilby of Charles City, Maureen Pagel, Iowa City, and Marcia (Jim) Jacobsen, and one brother Leon (Shirley) Hall all of Charles City.

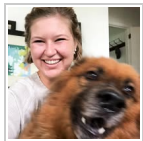
