Lois W. Adams, 84 formerly of 322 S. Main, Marble Rock, died Friday, October 19, 2018, at the Nora Springs Care Center.

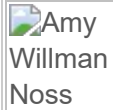

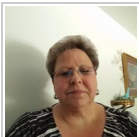

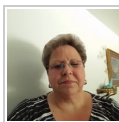
