Marvin Eugene Bohl, 88, of Mason City, Iowa, passed away peacefully on Thursday, April 23, 2026, at MercyOne North Iowa Medical Center. Funeral arrangements are being handled by Fullerton Funeral Home.

A Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 29, 2026, at Fullerton Funeral Home, 123 2nd St SE, Mason City, with visitation beginning one hour prior to the service. Following the service, Marvin will be laid to rest at Elmwood-St. Joseph Cemetery.

Marvin was born on August 27, 1937, in Mason City to Vern and Agnes (Olson) Bohl. He proudly served his country in the United States Air Force from 1955 to 1959, during which time he earned his GED. He was honorably discharged from the reserves in 1963.

On February 20, 1960, Marvin was united in marriage to Katherine (Kiroff) Bohl. Together, they shared 66 wonderful years and built a loving family, raising three sons: Terry, Jeffrey, and Brian.

Marvin dedicated 33 years of his career at Lehigh Cement Company before retiring in 1998. In his free time, he enjoyed going to the Newman Knight baseball and basketball games, reading, working on puzzles, and lending a hand to his sons with various projects—whether they asked for help or not. He also enjoyed golfing at Rockwell's Linn Grove Golf Course and bowling in the

Knights of Columbus bowling league. Marvin was a devoted Chicago Cubs fan, especially when they were having a winning season.

Above all, Marvin will be remembered as a loving husband, being the main caregiver for his wife Katherine for the past 28 years after she suffered a stroke in 1998, father, and a grandfather whose presence brought warmth and humor to those around him.
