Marvin "Butch" Allen Davis, 76, of Mason City, IA died Saturday, May 27, 2017, peacefully at his home.

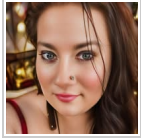

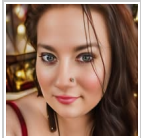
