Ruby M. Kopps, 94 of Mason City, died Friday, May 24, 2024 at the IOOF home.

For fourteen years she and her twin were "Rocking Grandmas" for the Charlie Brown day care center. Ruby enjoyed playing cards, dice and bingo. She loved gardening, flowers and yard work and especially spending time with grandchildren and great grandchildren... She

enjoyed reading her bible, and the times she and her husband went to dog and horse races and dancing in their younger years.
