Viola Mae Laffler, 91, of Charles City, IA died Saturday, October 15, 2016, at Floyd County Memorial Hospital. Per her wishes she will be cremated and a private family scattering will take place at a later date.

Viola was born on July 11, 1925, in Shenandoah, IA to Earl and Anna (Trout) Kline.
